- AxiomV ExacqVision version 5.2.79 integration patch




The Exacq Integration patch is Licensed by RBH and sold only to authorized RBH dealers.

Installing the Exacq integration patch:



• click Next....




• Browse to your AxiomV installation folder and click Run




• Installation completed. Start AxiomV client

Setting up the Integration:


• Go to *Operators* and Add Exacq operator(s) to AxiomV. Note: the AxiomV operator logon credentials must also be in the Exacq VMS system



• Go to Database, DVR and select New. Select Exacq and enter the address and port number of the VMS to connect to.




• Click on connect to test Connection.
